Duties of this Committee shall be to make recommendations for items for discussion at the coming A.G.M. if thought necessary. Also this Executive would have the powers of an appeals committee and as such could be asked to meet, at the discretion of the Secretary, if any problem should arrise through out the season. 4. That the Headquarters be a suitable venue in the Birmingham & District area, where meetings may be held. 5. Races to be confined to FIRST CLAIM MEMBERS of member Clubs, and the rules of the M.C.C.CA. and the M.C.A.A. to apply. 6. That the League be divided into four divisions containing Clubs of equal strength. The two Clubs finishing first and second in the 2nd., 3rd., and 4th. divisions to move to the higher Division, and the two Clubs at the bottom of the tables in Divisions 1;2 and 3 to move into a lower division. Winners and runners up in each Division to receive League awards respectively, also the Individual winner, on points, in each division to receive a League award. 7. That the distances of races be from 5 to 7 miles, and races to be decided on championship 8. Affiliation Fee to be decided at the A.G.M.(at present £8-00.)per Club per Annum.Numbers and result sheets to be supplied by the League. 9. Any Club which fails to pay its affiliation Fee prior to the first race after the A.G.M. shall have their invitation to compete in the League withdrawn. 10. Each race shall be in the charge of an appointed Referee whose decision shall be final. League Timekeepers for each division shall also be appointed at the A.G.M. and will be responsible for giving and recording the Official Times at each race. The races to be stærted by an appointed starter. 11. The Hon. Secretary of the promoting Club shall arrange judges, officials and FIRST AID cover for each race, and a disc system of scoring shall be used. Each Club will provide its own disc steward. 12. Any Club failing to complete a team in all fixtures shall automatically finish at the bottom of the table in the final League placings. Failing to complete a team in the Fourth Division fixtures shall mean that the Club applies in writing (before the next A.G.M.) to the Hom. Secretary for re-election to the League. 13. The Dates and venues of all Leagues races shall be decided at the A.G.M.

Birmingham & District Invitation Cross Country League. Executive meeting held at the Alexander Stadium, Birmingham on Friday 3rd. May 85. J. Andrews (President), B. Carr; K. Dare; E. Hutchings; D. Johnson; H. Mortimer; T.O'Reilly; and C.B.Franks. Were recieved from J.Skidmore. Apologies. Affiliations. Bill Adcocks 1984 A.G.M. proposals that affiliations should be raised and that Clubs promoting League fixtures should be partially recompenced, was extensively discussed and many alternative ideas put forward as possibilities, however in the end the meeting came back to the opinion that the original proposal had most merit. The following points came strongly out in its favour. i)Simplicity and straight forward to administrate. ii)Encourage Clubs to promote League Races. iii)Would assist Clubs financially in promoting fixtures, especially the smaller Clubs. · iv)The League is well organised and provides competion of a very high standard in all four divisions, therefore provides good value for money. v) It could be argued against; that doubling the affiliation fee would be a burded on some Clubs, but it was noted that the average entry from each Club was getting on towards twenty athletes at each fixture, this breaks down to 10p. for each athlete at each fixture at the present affiliation of £8 - 00.8y doubling the fee this would equate to 20p. per athlete per fixture. Even Clubs who put out the minimum of six athletes at each fixture would only be paying out less than 67p. per athlete, a very moderate entry fee for competition of this standard. vi) The burden of cost on the Clubs who are willing to put themselves out and promote fixtures for the League would be shared by those Clubs who are unable to promote fixtures. Making a far fairer system. Bill Carr proposed, seconded by Henry Mortimer that the following proposal be put to the 1985 A.G.M. "The League affiliation for the 1985-86 season be increased to £16 - 00. and that each of the promoting Clubs be reimbursed by £20 -20. after the fixture they have promoted " This motion was passed by a large majority of the Executive, there being no delegate against. The Executive agreed that if more than four Clubs put in for a League Fixture in any of the Divisions it would only be correct that any Club not getting a fixture in the present season be given priority the following season. Application for League Fixtures.

An addition to Rule 13 was agreed should be put to the A.G.M.:-"and that those Clubs giving written application to stage a League fixture shall be given preferance when choosing venues for the coming season." Ineligibility of Guest Runners. The vexed question of Guest/Ghost runners caused a great deal of discussion, with the Executaive unanimous in its condemnation of allowing Guests to run in League fixtures. They agreed that the A.G.M. should be asked to add the following to Rule 5. :-"No quest runners." In short it was agreed that guests could affect the way a race was run and could produce a result that would not have been, if guests were excluded. Also the Executive believed that the League was not in existence for runners serving nine months ban for moving Clubs. These athletes MUST find another outlet for their exertions and not use the League as a convenient method of competition. Promotion of League Races. It was thought by the Executive that it would be helpful to new Clubs who have recently joined the League if the Secretary would construct a brief of things to be done when organising a League Promotion, the brief would also be useful to established Clubs as a check list. The Secretary was asked to produce this brief for the A.G.M. in September. Officials. The League will require a new Race Secretary for Division twp.Clubs are asked to make enquiries of their members to see if a volenteer can be found. Also needed for some divisions are Judges and Timekeepers. Review of Divisions. Division One. Reference was made to University Runners competing out of Club vests, this contravenes rule 15 of the League. Referees are to be told to be much stricter on the Club colours rule for the 1985 -86 season.
