

Delegates to the M.C.C.C.A. :- D.Bacon, D.Johnson, R.Tilling.  
Divisional representation on the Executive:- This year all race secretaries were voted on to the Leagues Executive i.e. W.Carr, H.Mortimer, B.Ewington and T.O'Reilly.

#### Affiliations.

This subject provoked much discussion after a proposal from Bill Adcocks that the League Affiliation should be increased to £17 - 00. His argument for this were:-

- i) In the main it was the same Clubs each year prepared to put on races, whilst other Clubs were prepared to ride on the backs of these Clubs who were prepared to do the work.
- ii) He thought those Clubs putting on a race were entitled to some recompence in a payment of £30 - 00. This would help off set some of the expenses of the host Club.
- iii) It may also encourage those Clubs who never put on races to perhaps share the burden of the work of putting races on.

Naturally this proposal sparked off a great discussion which in fact split the meeting considerably. After some time it was agreed that it would be difficult to raise the affiliation to this sum without the Clubs having a chance to discuss the matter at their committees. It was therefore agreed that the Leagues executive should discuss the matter with a view to putting a proposal on the matter at next years A.G.M.

Arthur Wright then proposed to the meeting, seconded by Bill Adcocks, that all Clubs promoting fixtures this season should draw up a Balance Sheet for their particular fixture and send it to the Secretary, so that it will help the Executive to draw up some proposals for next years meeting. This proposal was carried unanimously.

It was then agreed that the Affiliation should remain at £8 - 00. for the coming season.

AFFILIATIONS ARE NOW DUE AND SHOULD BE SENT TO THE TREASURER BEFORE THE FIRST RACE ON NOVEMBER THE 3rd. 1984. Any Club not having sent in their affiliation by that date will not be allowed to run.

#### Any Other Business.

It was asked that the Executive look at the problems concerned with applications to stage races from Clubs. Should Clubs who write in take preference over those who make their application orally to the Secretary?

A proposal that League Races should start fifteen minutes earlier than at present was narrowly defeated by 27 votes to 20, there were a number of abstentions. League Races remain at their old starting time of Young Athletes 14:30hrs and the Senior Race at 15:00hrs.

It was agreed to buy Arm Bands for Race Officials so that they can be distinguished at League Races. Clubs said that they did not always know who to give their envelopes to at the end of the meetings, the arm bands should solve this problem.  
Date of the 60th. A.G.M.

It was agreed to hold the 60th. A.G.M. on the 11th. of September 1985, once again at the Alexander Stadium, Birmingham.

There being no further business the meeting thanked Roy Tilling and Birchfield Harriers for the use of their Club Room.

The President closed the meeting at 22:45hrs.

### RULES.

1. That the name of the League be the Birmingham & District Invitation Cross Country League.
  2. That the objects of the League be the promotion of combined races, allowing any numbers of runners to compete.
  3. That the management of the League be vested in a President, Vice Presidents, (One from each Club with power to add) three delegates from each Club, Hon. Secretary, Hon. Treasurer, also an Asst. Secretary & Treasures, if the A.G.M. feel that these assistant Officers are necessary, all of whom shall be elected at the Annual General Meeting each year with the Past Presidents.
  - 3a. An Executive Committee shall be elected at the A.G.M. and will consist of the following:-
    - i) The President.
    - ii) The Hon. Secretary.
    - iii) The Race Referees.
    - iv) One representative from each of the Leagues four Divisions, to be elected each year at the A.G.M.
- This Executive should be instructed to meet once a year after the close of each season to discuss relevant matters from the preceding season. Duties of this Committee shall be to make recommendations for items for discussion at the coming A.G.M. if thought necessary. Also this Executive would have the powers of an appeals committee and as such could be asked to meet, at the discretion of the Secretary, if any problem should arise through out the season.
4. That the Headquarters be a suitable venue in the Birmingham & District area, where meetings may be held.
  5. Races to be confined to FIRST CLAIM MEMBERS of member Clubs, and the rules of the M.C.C.C.A. and the M.C.A.A.A. to apply.
  6. That the League be divided into four divisions containing Clubs of equal strength. The two Clubs finishing first and second in the 2nd., 3rd., and 4th. divisions to move to the higher Division, and the two Clubs at the bottom of the tables in Divisions 1; 2 and 3 to move into a lower division. Winners and runners up in each Division to receive League awards respectively, also the Individual winner, on points, in each division to receive a League award.
  7. That the distances of races be from 5 to 7 miles, and races to be decided on championship lines.
  8. Affiliation Fee to be decided at the A.G.M. (at present £8-00.) per Club per Annum. Numbers and result sheets to be supplied by the League.
  9. Any Club which fails to pay its affiliation Fee prior to the first race after the A.G.M. shall have their invitation to compete in the League withdrawn.
  10. Each race shall be in the charge of an appointed Referee whose decision shall be final. League Timekeepers for each division shall also be appointed at the A.G.M. and will be responsible for giving and recording the Official Times at each race. The races to be started by an appointed starter.
  11. The Hon. Secretary of the promoting Club shall arrange judges, officials and FIRST AID cover for each race, and a disc system of scoring shall be used. Each Club will provide its own disc steward.
  12. Any Club failing to complete a team in all fixtures shall automatically finish at the bottom of the table in the final League placings. Failing to complete a team in the Fourth Division fixtures shall mean that the Club applies in writing (before the next A.G.M.) to the Hon. Secretary for re-election to the League.
  13. The Dates and venues of all Leagues races shall be decided at the A.G.M.
  14. The Hon. Secretary of each promoting Club MUST inform all Clubs in his division, The President, Hon. Secretary, Race Secretary, The Referee, Judges, and the Timekeepers as to the venue, travel details and the type and distance of the course at least 14 days before the race is to be run.
  15. Club Colours must be worn. The Referee will disqualify any athlete who does not comply with this rule.
  16. Safety pins are not provided by the League for athletes numbers, this is the responsibility of individual Clubs to provide. The Leagues judges would appreciate if athletes could pin their numbers on the sides, rather than top and bottom of the number.
  17. The Young Athletes race shall be for boys who are over 13 years of age but under 17 years of age on the 1st. September prior to the first League race of the season. The distance of the races shall NOT exceed 3 miles.
  18. The responsibility for the up to date engraving of the League Trophies, is that of the holding Club.

Birmingham & District Invitation Cross Country League.

Executive meeting held at the Alexander Stadium, Birmingham on Friday 3rd. May 85.

Attendance.

J. Andrews (President), B. Carr; K. Dare; E. Hutchings; D. Johnson; H. Mortimer; T. O'Reilly; and C. B. Franks.

Apologies.

Were recieved from J. Skidmore.

Affiliations.

Bill Adcocks 1984 A.G.M. proposals that affiliations should be raised and that Clubs promoting League fixtures should be partially recompenced, was extensively discussed and many alternative ideas put forward as possibilities, however in the end the meeting came back to the opinion that the original proposal had most merit. The following points came strongly out in its favour.

- i) Simplicity and straight forward to administrate.
- ii) Encourage Clubs to promote League Races.
- iii) Would assist Clubs financially in promoting fixtures, especially the smaller Clubs.
- iv) The League is well organised and provides competition of a very high standard in all four divisions, therefore provides good value for money.
- v) It could be argued against; that doubling the affiliation fee would be a burdud on some Clubs, but it was noted that the average entry from each Club was getting on towards twenty athletes at each fixture, this breaks down to 10p. for each athlete at each fixture at the present affiliation of £8 - 00. By doubling the fee this would equate to 20p. per athlete per fixture. Even Clubs who put out the minimum of six athletes at each fixture would only be paying out less than 67p. per athlete, a very moderate entry fee for competition of this standard.
- vi) The burden of cost on the Clubs who are willing to put themselves out and promote fixtures for the League would be shared by those Clubs who are unable to promote fixtures. Making a far fairer system.

Bill Carr proposed, seconded by Henry Mortimer that the following proposal be put to the 1985 A.G.M.

"The League affiliation for the 1985-86 season be increased to £16 - 00. and that each of the promoting Clubs be reimbursed by £20 - 00. after the fixture they have promoted " This motion was passed by a large majority of the Executive, there being no delegate against.

The Executive agreed that if more than four Clubs put in for a League Fixture in any of the Divisions it would only be correct that any Club not getting a fixture in the present season be given priority the following season.

Application for League Fixtures.

An addition to Rule 13 was agreed should be put to the A.G.M.:-  
"and that those Clubs giving written application to stage a League fixture shall be given preference when choosing venues for the coming season."

Ineligibility of Guest Runners.

The vexed question of Guest/Ghost runners caused a great deal of discussion, with the Executive unanimous in its condemnation of allowing Guests to run in League fixtures. They agreed that the A.G.M. should be asked to add the following to Rule 5. :-  
"No guest runners."

In short it was agreed that guests could affect the way a race was run and could produce a result that would not have been, if guests were excluded. Also the Executive believed that the League was not in existence for runners serving nine months ban for moving Clubs. These athletes MUST find another outlet for their exertions and not use the League as a convenient method of competition.

Promotion of League Races.

It was thought by the Executive that it would be helpful to new Clubs who have recently joined the League if the Secretary would construct a brief of things to be done when organising a League Promotion, the brief would also be useful to established Clubs as a check list. The Secretary was asked to produce this brief for the A.G.M. in September.

Officials.

The League will require a new Race Secretary for Division twp. Clubs are asked to make enquiries of their members to see if a volenteer can be found. Also needed for some divisions are Judges and Timekeepers.

Review of Divisions.

Division One.

Reference was made to University Runners competing out of Club vests, this contravenes rule 15 of the League. Referees are to be told to be much stricter on the Club colours rule for the 1985 -86 season.



On the subject of Universities Ken Dare stressed the importance that they MUST send the names of all University Athletic Club members and their home Clubs to the M.C.A.A. before they can compete in Open Competition for the University, this includes the Birmingham Cross Country League. (The names of athletes that do not belong to Clubs must also be sent for scrutiny by the Midlands.)

Division Two.

Henry Mortimer informed the Executive that he had found the separate declaration sheets for each meeting a great improvement. This comment was endorsed by the other divisions.

Division Three.

It was noted in the absence of any delegate from this Division that the Referee had had to disqualify several athletes for not wearing Club Colours.

Division Four.

Generally it was felt that starting this new Division was most worth-while, the only shortcoming was the lack of Officials the burden being put on to just two people.

A.O.B.

There was a short discussion on the starting time of races but it was agreed that the present arrangement for League timings could not be improved upon; and was generally satisfactory to most Clubs.

As there was no further business the meeting closed at 21:15hrs.
