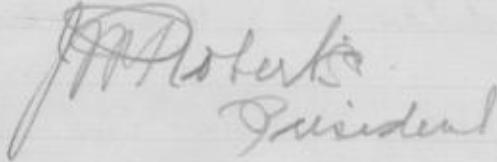
A revision of rules for the League competition
